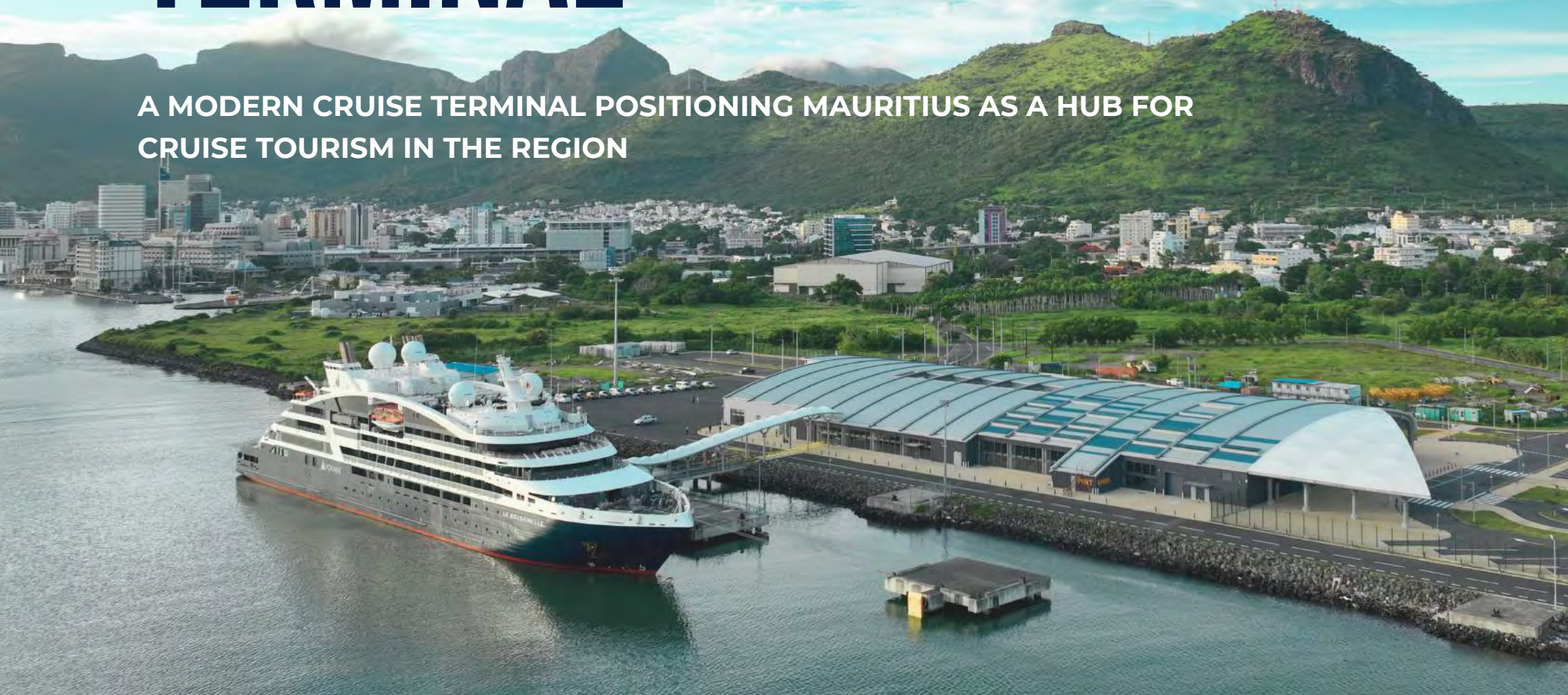


PORT LOUIS CRUISE TERMINAL

Ecotourism, golf, heritage, scenic beauty, culture and above all the mixed local population, all contribute to the promotion of inter-island tourism.

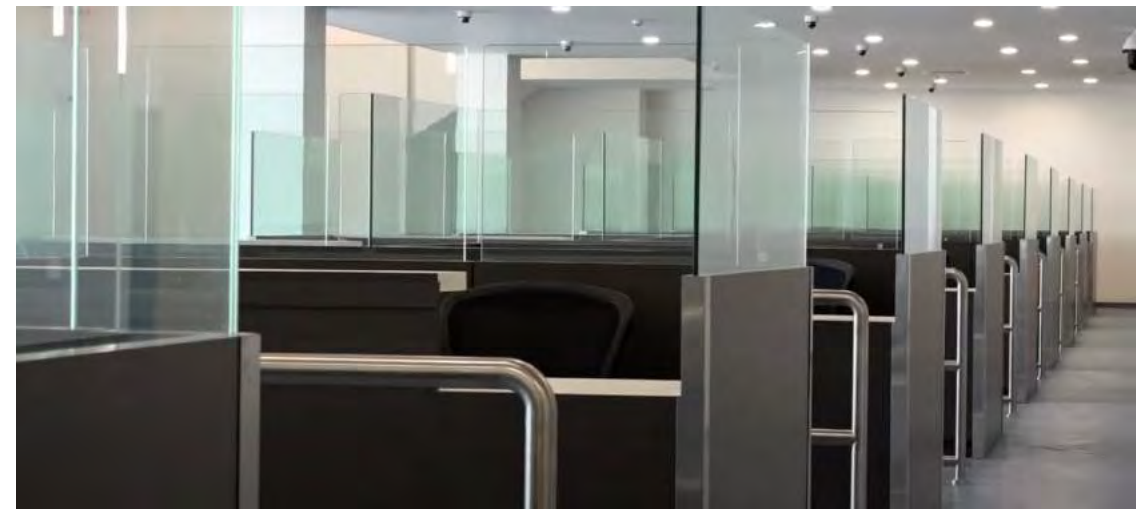
Financed by the Mauritius Ports Authority (MPA) and constructed at a cost of approximately US\$ 20 million, the cruise terminal offers all facilities of international standard for the handling of cruise passengers.



Terminal Details

Floor Area	7335 m ²
Passenger capacity	4000 peak passengers
Passenger waiting hall	2000 m ²
Passenger security area	160 m ² with 5 stations
Immigration and Customs area	1250 m ² with 22 stations
Baggage claim area	900 m ²

The cruise terminal provides for security screening of passengers and luggage, passenger waiting and baggage sorting.
